FESTIVAL OF THE NINE LESSONS AND CAROLS
From King's College at Cambridge University

**To be Broadcast by Live Satellite Transmission
on 88.7 KCME-FM - December 24th at 8:00 AM**

88.7 KCME-FM is proud to announce that for the first time in Colorado Springs, listeners will be able to hear the live-by-satellite transmission of the world-famous *Festival of the Nine Lessons and Carols* from King's College at Cambridge University.

On Christmas Eve morning, December 24th at 8:00AM, 88.7 KCME will broadcast a live, two-hour music and spoken-word broadcast from the Chapel of King's College in Cambridge, England.

In July 1445, the foundation stone for the chapel was laid by the Plantagenet King Henry the 6th. In this magnificent fan-vaulted chapel, the 30-voice choir of men and boys follow the service form and liturgy originated by Dean of the College, Eric Milner-White in 1918.

In 1928, a broader public first heard the Festival over the British Broadcasting Corporation, and this annual tradition has enjoyed an unbroken broadcast history, even during the years of World War II when the Festival service continued in defiance of Nazi bombers and V-2s.

The BBC now makes this beautiful Christmas observance available to a world-wide audience via satellite transmission.
